

School Uniform Policy 2017

Policy Statement

All pupils are expected to wear school uniform. The staff and governors believe it gives the school an identity and encourages the children to take pride in both their appearance and their school. At Hazel Slade Primary School we feel that wearing school uniform reinforces our ethos and allows your child to be an integral part of our nurturing and caring community.

The school sweatshirt colour is green.

Sweatshirts, polo shirts, fleeces and P.E bags with an embroidered Hazel Slade logo are available for purchase from: Crested Schoolwear Cannock, Tesco Direct (online service).

We encourage the wearing of school badges for the children's safety as it makes them more identifiable.

Children are given a school book bag with a Hazel Slade logo and their name on when they start school in the Reception or Nursery Year – there is no need to purchase a school Book Bag.

Children are encouraged to wear sun hats or caps during hot weather: caps with the school logo are available as are fleece hats for cold weather.

Children should wear:

- Polos shirts in white
- Sweatshirts, jumpers or cardigans in green
- Long or short trousers in grey or black
- Knee length skirts or pinafore dresses in grey or black
- Knee length dresses in **green check**
- Tights and socks must be in **plain white**, **black**, **grey or green**. (No footless tights, socks above the knee or leggings).

Shoes:

- Black shoes or plain black trainers (no other colours, logos or wheels).
- All shoes should have a low heel.
- Laces should be **plain black**. Where possible shoes should be fastened with **Velcro** in the Early Years and Key Stage 1.

Children are expected to wear school uniform unless there is a justified reason why they may not. If your child cannot temporarily wear uniform, please send in a letter stating the reasons why or speak to your child's class teacher.

PE Uniform:

- Plain black shorts or school logo shorts
- Plain white t-shirt or school logo t-shirt
- Black PE pumps
- Outdoor trainers
- Plain black, navy or grey jogging bottoms and jacket (no logos)
- On swimming days children are encouraged to wear plain black, navy or grey tracksuit bottoms with their school sweatshirt and a white t. shirt or polo shirt- this makes changing easier.

Jewellery:

- Children may wear watches to school and plain stud earrings. No other items of jewellery are permitted.
- For health and safety reasons earrings must be removed for PE lessons. If your child is unable to remove the earrings themselves they must come to school with them removed on the days they have PE lessons.

Hair:

- For health and safety reasons hair must be tied back if it is below shoulder length.
- No shaved patterns in hair or extreme hair cuts are permitted.
- Hair gel is permitted in moderation but no Mohican style hairstyles are allowed.

Other Items:

- Nail varnish is not permitted in school.
- Temporary tattoos are not permitted in school.

Please ensure all items of your child's clothing are clearly labelled with their name.
